**** Dressage Tests & Jumping Classes** – you may sign up for as many rounds as you would like at any level.

July 27th Championship Divisions

You will have the opportunity to be crowned the Summer Series Show Champion or Reserve Champion for either Dressage, Western Dressage included. To qualify to compete in the championship division, you will need to pay \$10. Awarded back in prize money.

For Dressage, the high points of the championship classes will be awarded champion and reserve.

****The show judge will determine any tie-breakers****

To Enter: You must denote on the July 27th entry form that you would like to compete for the Summer Series Show Champion in dressage and pay an additional \$10 on your entry.

Information & Facility Rules

1. **Directions:**

From Hwy 93, turn left onto Rocky Cliff Drive 1.2 miles, Turn left onto Airport Rd then continue onto Foys Canyon Road, Turn left onto Foys Lake Road. Herron Park will be on your right, continue past the first parking lot to the stabling area. From the Kalispell, turn onto Foys Lake Road 4 miles, Turn Right onto Foys Lake Road, Herron Park will be on your right, continue past the first parking lot to the stabling area.

The private easement speed limit is 15 mph, please drive slow and respect the neighbors. Please park in the designated area for your vehicle.

2. **Warm-up:**

Day-of show warm-up schooling is allowed all day in the designated warm-up arena and around the perimeter of the dressage court prior to the show.

3. **Bridle Tags Required:**

All horses must submit an entry form and wear the assigned bridle tag at all times while on the show grounds day-of show. **Please return tags to the show office at the end of the show.**

4. **Haul-ins:**

All haul-in horses must follow these rules, or be moved to a stall and charged the stabling fees:

- a) Horses tied to trailers must be supervised at all times
- b) Horses must not be allowed to dig holes in the gravel
- c) Horse manure must be cleaned up immediately

5. **Stabling:**

Stalls are available on-site and are a first come, first serve basis. **It is \$25/night to stay at the park and the fee is payable to Flathead County Parks and Recreation.** Payment can be left in the brown box below the Herron Park sign at the entrance to stabling.

You are responsible to bring your own water buckets, bucket hangers, bridle and saddle racks, wheelbarrows, and pitchforks. Stalls must be mucked clean before you leave. Stall and manure, bedding, and feed may be deposited on site in the manure bins.

Portable restrooms are available

9. **Concessions** will not be available. Please bring your own snacks/meals and beverages.

10. **BBQ's are not allowed** on the show grounds.

11. Smoking and Pets:

No smoking on show grounds! Dogs must be leashed at all times and the owner is responsible for any damage or injury caused by the dog on the show grounds. Please pick up after your dog.

12. Noise:

Please be quiet while exhibitors are riding their tests. Sudden noises, crinkling of food wrappers, etc can spook and distract horses.

13. Garbage:

Please dispose of all **garbage** in the designated trash bins.

14. Helmets:

Required. Anyone mounted at any time must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets, including WDAA riders.

15. Awards & Ribbons:

All score cards must be picked up the day of show and will be available throughout the day. 1-3rd place ribbons will be provided.

16. Attire:

At a minimum, riders shall present a respectful tidy appearance. Show clothes are not required.

17. Tack:

No boots, bell boots, or polo wraps allowed for dressage tests. Regulation bits, appropriate for your division, required. Hunter/Jumper and Western saddles are allowed. For more info on bits:

18. Competition Rules:

USEF rules will apply as guidelines for all NW Equestrian LLC Sponsored events. Please contact the Event Organizers listed with any additional questions.

19. Dressage Tests:

Rides will be judged on current USDF, USEF, USEA, & WDAA tests.

20. Rules & Regulations:

All participants must comply with the Tri-H Stables Rules and regulations and the directions and instructions given by the BDS Club.

21. Show Office:

The show office, announcer, vendors, and prize booth will be located on the South side of the indoor arena, just inside the large garage doors, opposite the large outdoor arena.

Cancellation Policy

If the show is canceled, all fees will be refunded. Scratches before the closing date will be refunded. Scratches after the closing date will not be refunded. Rider/horse substitutions may be made for the same class/test entries on the day of the show, in lieu of a scratch. No entries will be carried over for future shows.
